ORDER AND JUDGMENT

A motion having regularly come on to be heard before this Court on the 18th day of February, 2009, for an Order and Judgment approving and confirming the final report ("Final Report") on the Liquidation (the "Liquidation Proceeding") of Medical Malpractice Insurance Association ("MMIA") by the Superintendent of Insurance of the State of New York as liquidator (the "Liquidator") of MMIA and for termination of said proceeding;

NOW, upon reading the Final Report, dated December 29, 2008, by Mark G. Peters, Special Deputy Superintendent (the "Special Deputy") and Agent of the Liquidator with due proof of service thereof upon the MMIA's policyholders, claimants and creditors with allowed claims and all other interested parties, the Petition of the Special Deputy in support of said motion, and due deliberation having been had thereon, and upon the decision of this Court;

NOW, on application of Andrew J. Lorin, Esq., Attorney for the Liquidator, it is

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED, that the petition to approve the Final Report is granted; and it is further

ORDER AND ADJUDGED, that the within Liquidation Proceeding is terminated and closed;

ORDER AND ADJUDGED, that the Liquidator, his predecessors and successors in office, their agents, attorneys and employees, are released and discharged from any and all liability arising from their acts or omissions in connection with the Liquidation Proceeding;

ORDER AND ADJUDGED, that the New York Liquidation Bureau be authorized to receive and disburse to the Miscellaneous Special Revenue Fund, without further application to this Court, any receipts that are received postdating the termination of the Liquidation Proceeding;

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED, that the Liquidator is authorized and directed to destroy or dispose of any and all of the books, files, records and other property of MMIA, without further order of the Court, *after 6 months from the date of this order*
