

Upon the August 12, 2021 affirmation of David Axinn in support of the motion of the liquidator ("Liquidator") of American Medical and Life Insurance Company ("AMLI") for an order allowing the omnibus claim filed by the National Organization of Life and Health Insurance Guaranty Associations ("Omnibus Claim"), in the amount of \$60,000 as a Class Four claim against the AMLI estate under New York Insurance Law Section 7435(a)(4).
