ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE

UPON the Verified Petition dated January 9, 2012, the exhibits thereto, and all the proceedings previously had herein,

LET any Interested Person or his, her or their attorneys show cause before this Court at the <sup>Albany County Courthouse</sup> ~~Justice Building~~, Albany, New York 12224, on the <sup>6<sup>th</sup></sup> ~~13<sup>th</sup>~~ day of <sup>April</sup> ~~March~~, 2012 at <sup>9:30</sup> in the <sup>fore</sup> noon of that day or as soon thereafter as counsel may be heard, why an order an order should not be made: (i) granting the Verified Petition of BENJAMIN M. LAWSKY, Superintendent of Financial Services of the State of New York, in his capacity as Rehabilitator (the "Rehabilitator") of FRONTIER INSURANCE COMPANY ("Frontier"), for an Order approving his Plan of Rehabilitation for Frontier; and (ii) allowing the Rehabilitator such other and further relief as the Court may deem just and proper.

AND, sufficient cause having been alleged therefor, let service of notice of this order to show cause and the papers upon which it is granted be made: (i) by posting of true copies of same on the website of the New York Liquidation Bureau ([www.nylb.org](http://www.nylb.org)) on or before January <sup>30</sup>, 2012; (ii) by publication in three consecutive

issues of *Business Insurance*; and (iii) by regular mail dispatched on or before January 30, 2012 and addressed to counsel for Interested Persons (or, for such Interested Persons who do not have counsel of record, to such Interested Persons themselves at their last known addresses as may be determined through a diligent search of Frontier's books and records); and it is further

ORDERED, that no Interested Person shall be entitled to object to the relief sought by the Rehabilitator or otherwise be heard, except by answering papers served on or before ~~February~~ <sup>March 16</sup> 16, 2012; and it is further

ORDERED, that the Rehabilitator may reply to any objection or other submission by papers served on or before March 30, 2012.
