ORDER

FRONTIER INSURANCE COMPANY

UPON the United States' Protective Verified Objection, dated February 25, 2014 ("Objection"), to the Verified Petition, dated December 20, 2013 ("Petition"), of John Pearson Kelly on behalf of the Superintendent of Financial Services of the State of New York as liquidator ("Liquidator") of Frontier Insurance Company ("Frontier"), and the United States' Request for an Extension of Time, dated February 25, 2014, and all the proceedings previously had herein, it is hereby:

ORDERED, that the United States is granted an extension of time until August 11, 2014 to file a brief in support of its Objection to the Petition and the Liquidator is granted an extension of time until August 25, 2014 to file its response; and it is further

ORDERED, that any appearances on the Objection will be scheduled after the Court's receipt and review of the written submissions; and it is further

ORDERED, that this Court reserves a decision on the Liquidator's request to establish December 31, 2014 as the Final Bar Date, pending this Court's decision on the Objection; and it is further

ORDERED, that the application of the Liquidator as set forth in the Petition is granted, except as otherwise noted herein; and it is further

ORDERED, that the Liquidator's Report on the Status of the Liquidation of Frontier Insurance Company and Request for Authority to Distribute Assets and Establish a Final Bar Date, as attached to the Petition, and the financial transactions delineated therein, are approved; and it is further

ORDERED, that the Liquidator is granted the continued authority to pay administrative expenses; and it is further

ORDERED, that the Liquidator is authorized to distribute Frontier's assets, consistent with this Court's orders and the priorities set forth in Insurance Law Section 7434, to those creditors of Frontier with allowed claims, to the extent that, in the Liquidator's discretion, sufficient funds are available.
