AND, sufficient cause having been alleged therefor and this Court having found the form and method of the notice specified herein to be the best notice practicable, it is hereby

## ORDERED, that:

The Notice in the form attached hereto be served on all creditors, claimants and other persons interested in the Companies' affairs by the method of service of the Notice, i.e., by United States first class mail to Lana Choy at 121 Vanderbilt Road, Manhasset, New York, and Gregory W. Gardellis at 3 Birchfield Road, Larchmont, New York, and to all other interested parties by publication in Business Insurance, once a week for two consecutive weeks commencing within four weeks of entry of this Order to Show Cause and posting on the Internet web page maintained by the New York Liquidation Bureau at <a href="http://nylb.org">http://nylb.org</a>, within 30 business days of entry of this order;
- 3. The form and method of the Notice specified herein shall constitute due and attacked affiliant sufficient notice of this Order to Show Cause, Verified Petition and Hearing to all persons and entities entitled to receive such notice;
- 4. Any person or entity wishing to object to the relief requested in the Verified

  Petition must serve a written statement, setting forth the objections and attaching all supporting documentation, upon the Liquidator and file same with the Clerk of the Court at least 15 business days prior to the above-
